



Christ to the Villages, Nigeria

I am thrilled to report that Sandy and I enjoyed a wonderful afternoon and dinner with Rev. Matthew Oladele and his wife from Christ to the Villages mission in Nigeria. Matthew and Mary had an extended visit to the United States to stay with his sister, Eunice Oladele Fayehun and her husband, Victor, near Colorado Springs, CO. One of the reasons for the visit was to be with Eunice for the birth of her first child, who was born on July 5th. In mid-August, Matthew

and Mary had some business to take care of in California. Sandy and I were blessed to spend some time with them. Our relationship with this mission goes back to the late 1990's when his father, Rev. Solomon Oladele and his wife Margaret visited Sandy's church, Faith Congregational Church in Monrovia. They were such dynamic Christian missionaries. Matthew took over after his father's death in 2009.



The pandemic has presented many additional challenges to their work at the mission. Besides school closures many people were out of work due to shut downs. Food was scarce. Matthew took upon the role of farmer and used some unplanted land on the cashew farm for growing



crops, esp. rice, to help the people of the nearby villages. There was very little help from the government and no vaccines.

Matthew and Mary returned to Nigeria at the beginning of September to be back for the start of a new school year. I am grateful that FCCA continues to support Christ to the Villages with our prayers and our donations.

farm will help provide financial resources to sustain Christ to the Villages. Matthew reports that all is going well with the trees.

And then there's the comfort and hope that has come to many over the years, when they enter the sanctuary doors, set aside worries and begin to sing & worship. That experience is as healing as ever.
